

Qatar invites bids for road improvement works

Qatar's Public Works Authority (Ashghal) has invited firms to submit bids by September 21 for two contracts aimed at addressing congestion in Doha, Meed has reported. The first project involves carrying road improvement works in the Al-Wakrah Municipality, which is south of greater Doha and the construction of temporary and permanent roads in zones 90 to 95. The second involves the construction of temporary and permanent roads and pavements, traffic signs and road markings and surface water drainage in various locations across Doha. Both projects are part of plans to invest \$20bn on new roads and related drainage and infrastructure over the next five years.
